The Colognole agricultural estate, or tenuta, was purchased by Conte Venceslao Spalletti in 1892, when, as a Senator in the Kingdom of Italy, he had to move his family from their native city of Reggio Emilia to Rome, to follow the King. He then acquired this property in Tuscany to remain close to the rural life that he had loved on his tenuta of Sant' Ilario in the region of Emilia. His sons Giambattista and Cesare, however, were the ones responsible for developing the potential of the estate during the first half of the 19th century. They gave its production the direction that still marks it today: the grapevine and the olive tree.

The Spalletti Chianti, in the 1960s, was one of the great ambassadors to the world of the Tuscan culture, and the great Reserve of Poggio Reale stood out for their elegance and impressive longevity. The tenuta is still owned by Contessa Gabriella Spalletti, and the Colognole agricultural operation, the azienda agricola, is managed by two among her five children, Mario and Cesare Coda Nunziante.

Castello di Poppiano is an impressive medieval building erected around the turn of the first millennium as a fortress for the external defence of the town of Florence. It has been the property of the Guicciardini for almost nine hundred years since the XII century. In the XVI certury it was owned by the Historian Francesco Guicciardini author of the "Historia d' Italia". Ferdinando Guicciardini , the present owner, inherited Castello di Poppiano and its estate in 1962, just as share-cropping (which had been for centuries the traditional farming contract in Tuscany) was coming to an end . That was a difficult period which ultimately led to radical changes to our estate , including crop specialization and upgrading of processing facilities, whilst bearing in mind the fundamental principle that progress should always respect tradition. Castello di Poppiano is located in the area of "Chianti Colli Fiorentini" ("Chianti Hills of Florence").

The history of Travignoli is connected to wine production since 1100, Vallembrosan records describe vineyards already under cultivation at the site of Travignoli in 28/11/110. In 1473 Travignoli is left to the Florentine Hospital Santa Maria Nuova in the will of its proprietor and Villa Travignoli is described as the most important of the hospital properties. In 1927 Clemente Busi becomes one of the founders of the Chianti Consortium. Today Travignoli is run by Giovanni Busi. The Busi family receives the "Italia 150" award from the Unioncamere Nazionale (Italian Chamber of Commerce). This award recognises Travignoli's success and longevity as one of the 150 most antique enterprises in Italy and in 2023 Travignoli celebrated its 550 years of history.
